- A. I, Hitesh D. I, Mr. Hitesh Buch, Practicing Company Secretary (CP No. 8195) have been appointed by the Board of Directors of Arvind Infrastructure Limited as Scrutinizer to conduct the e-voting process by way of electronic means in accordance with Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act') read with Rule 20(3)(xi) of Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014.

- 1.
